OFFICIAL SECRETS ACT 1989 - DECLARATION

Employees and Police Officers are required to sign the Official Secrets Act on commencing employment with Wiltshire Police.

In effect this means that it is an offence for an individual who is bound by the Act to make any unauthorised disclosure of information, document or other article which:

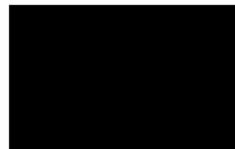
1. Results in an offence;
2. Leads to an escape from custody or undermines the safekeeping of individuals in custody;
3. Impedes the prevention or detention of crime or the apprehension or prosecution of suspected offenders.

It is important that as an employee of Wiltshire Police you are also aware of the above. Wiltshire Police offers you this employment on the basis that you acknowledge your own responsibility to maintaining the confidentiality of information you may obtain during your employment and sign the following undertaking.

I, [REDACTED], being an employee of Wiltshire Police hereby declare that I have read the above and that I fully understand that I must not divulge to any unauthorised person any information which may come to my knowledge or into my possession during the course of my employment.
