CLPDS

Common Law Police Disclosure (CLPD) Scheme - The disclosure of information to employers or regulatory bodies where an **urgent pressing social need** can be established relating to the particular access that an individual has to other people by virtue of their **employment** or **voluntary** role. Where police can use their professional judgement to make disclosures based on common law in circumstances where they consider this to be necessary to support public protection. An 'urgent pressing social need' involves the safeguarding or protection from harm of an individual, a group of individuals or society at large; in particular vulnerable adults and children. This need to safeguard must be proportionate whilst balancing the needs, rights and interests of the person in question. It will involve considering the impact of disclosure on the private life of the individual concerned.
