Please Note

Due to limitations in the use of “wildcard” or “free-text” searches, Wiltshire Police do not normally use this methodology of searching for information in this manner unless an applicant specifically asks for their use (as you have in this request).

The results provided above need to be referenced to the following specific caveats :-

- a) We are only able to undertake searches of this nature on the abbreviated description of a crime or an incident (which is limited to some 200-300 characters) rather than on the full content of the whole occurrence / incident log.**
- b) If one of your “keywords” is featured in the full occurrence / incident log but NOT the abbreviated summary, then it will not be returned in any results obtained using this method.**
- c) All “wildcard” or “free-text” searches are reliant on the specific words or phrases searched for being spelt grammatically correctly. If – for instance – the phrase sodium nitrate is spelt as say “sodium nutrate”, it will not feature in any results obtained using this methodology.**

Due to these limitations, Wiltshire Police would not ordinarily publish information in the public domain (as this FOI response will effectively be) without drawing notice to the above limitations / caveats.

I am satisfied that all the relevant information has been passed to me and been considered in the light of your request within the time constraints applicable under the legislation.

Freedom of Information Request Appeals Procedure

1. Who Can Ask for a Review

Any person who has requested information from Wiltshire Police, which has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act, is entitled to complain and request an internal review, if they are dissatisfied with the response they received.

2. How to Request a Review

Requests for review of a Freedom of Information request must be made in writing to the:

The reference number, date of the request and details of why the review is being requested must be included. Requests for review should be brought to the attention of the Force Disclosure Unit within 20 working days of the Force's response to the original FoI request.

3. Review Procedure

Receipt of a request for review will be acknowledged in writing to include confirmation of the reasons for the review. The review will be conducted by another Decision Maker, who is independent from the original Decision Maker. The Force Disclosure Unit will set a target date for a response. The response will be made as soon as is practicable with the intention to complete the review within twenty working days. In more complex cases the review may take up to 40 working days.

The Independent Decision Maker will conduct a review of the handling of the request for information and of decisions taken, including decisions taken about where the public interest lies in respect of exempt information where applicable. The review enables a re-evaluation of the case, taking into account the matters raised by the complaint.

4. Conclusion of the Appeal

On completion of the review the Independent Decision Maker will reply to the complainant with the result of the review. If the complainant is still dissatisfied following the review they should contact the Information Commissioner to make an appeal.
