I write in connection with your request for information dated 7th April 2024 regarding arrest warrants.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by the warrants department at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows.

3. What is the average length that outstanding arrest warrants have been outstanding for?
4. If information is easily available, what is the largest offence category / descriptor for outstanding arrest warrants?

Our response:

1. 396
2. 6th June 2005, sexual assault of a female
3. No information held
4. Unlawful driving
