I write in connection with your request for information dated 28th September 2024 regarding officer intelligence training.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by Learning and Development at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows.

You wrote:

Can you please provide how many hours of training with regards to intelligence student officers receive in their initial phase of training. (22 weeks).

Our response:

As it stands, student officers receive 3 hours which is delivered by the training team. However, we are currently in review of what is being delivered to new recruits in initial training. We are looking to move over to a model where this is delivered by the intel team as subject matter experts.

I am satisfied that all the relevant information has been passed to me and been considered in the light of your request within the time constraints applicable under the legislation.
