Dear XXXXX,

I write in connection with your request for information dated 26th November 2024, concerning OnlyFans crimes.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by the Business Intelligence department at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows.

You wrote:

Could you please search provide me with details of reported crimes where a search of the MO section of your crime database refers to "onlyfans" or "Only Fans". My request relates to crimes reported during the last five years from November 2019 to November 2024.

I would like to know the number of crimes reported over this period and can you please also provide me with the copies or summaries of the MO section of the incident report, with any personal data removed or redacted?

Lastly, could you tell me the outcome of each case - whether there were any arrests, prosecutions and convictions, or whether they were NFAed?

Our response:

For the period requested (November 2019 to November 2024), there were 7 crimes recorded.

Please note: This data was obtained by completing an MO summary search for the terms "Only Fans" and "OnlyFans". The results of these types of searches may be unreliable and inaccurate as only the summary field of the report is searched. If these terms are contained elsewhere (i.e. within the call log, crime report, statements etc) these will not be returned in the results. Additionally, if the term is misspelt within the summary field, this will not be returned. To provide accurate results would require a manual search of each crime within the specified timeframe to deem if they were relevant to your request.

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MO summary field descriptions – Note: Identifiable information has been redacted.

- Known female suspect has uploaded nude photos to Instagram and an explicit video and photos to an Only Fans page. The accounts have since been shut down and the suspect has had her phone taken off her.
- the known male suspect has taken a photo of the IP performing a sexual act on him, which she was aware of. The suspect has created a "Only Fans" page and used the photo of the IP without her permission. The IP and suspect are also the only people who would have access to this image.
- The suspect called the IP numerous times on a private number and when she answered he said TAKE MY ONLY FANS DOWN and I CHEATED ON YOU.
- IP states that her ex partner has threatened to post her nude photo's from Onlyfans onto social media.
- Known suspect has been using an 'Only Fans' account which has not been registered with, or approved by, Police, as he required to do.
- Breach of sexual harm prevention order by known male after suspicion he is using an onlyfans account which has not been declared to police
- Suspect has been verbally abusive and violent towards to the IP. He has also sent intimate photos of her to her friends and used her card without permission to purchase only fans subscriptions

Please note: Conviction data is Court data and is not held by Wiltshire Police. I would suggest you contact the Courts directly to see if they are able to assist with this part of your request.

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Freedom of Information Request Appeals Procedure

1. Who Can Ask for a Review

Any person who has requested information from Wiltshire Police, which has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act, is entitled to complain and request an internal review, if they are dissatisfied with the response they received.

2. How to Request a Review

Requests for review of a Freedom of Information request must be made in writing to the:

The reference number, date of the request and details of why the review is being requested must be included. Requests for review should be brought to the attention of the Force Disclosure Unit within 20 working days of the Force's response to the original FoI request.

3. Review Procedure

Receipt of a request for review will be acknowledged in writing to include confirmation of the reasons for the review. The review will be conducted by another Decision Maker, who is independent from the original Decision Maker. The Force Disclosure Unit will set a target date for a response. The response will be made as soon as is practicable with the intention to complete the review within twenty working days. In more complex cases the review may take up to 40 working days.

The Independent Decision Maker will conduct a review of the handling of the request for information and of decisions taken, including decisions taken about where the public interest lies in respect of exempt information where applicable. The review enables a re-evaluation of the case, taking into account the matters raised by the complaint.

4. Conclusion of the Appeal

On completion of the review the Independent Decision Maker will reply to the complainant with the result of the review. If the complainant is still dissatisfied following the review they should contact the Information Commissioner to make an appeal.
