77 LCV's and 1 HGV

Please also provide the annual volume of glass items that you; replace or repair, and also the number of ADAS recalibrations that you undertake each year?

36 in house chips and side window repairs, 38 Windscreen Replacements. Approx 90% of windscreen replacements have ADAS recalibrations

Please provide the £ value that you spent on vehicle glass replacement, repair and recalibration over the past 12 months?

Keeping Wiltshire Safe

Approx £38k for 24-25 calendar year

Please can you advise when you will be looking to go to tender for vehicle glass replacement, repair and recalibration services?

The current contract was awarded for one year from April 2025. The re-tender process will commence from November 25 into early 2026 for re-awarding in March 2026.

I am satisfied that all the relevant information has been passed to me and considered in the light of your request within the time constraints applicable under the legislation.
