I write in connection with your request for information dated 5th June 2026, concerning Data Protection Impact Assessments and Data Sharing Agreements for Police Led Partnerships referenced in Counter Terror Policing Prevent Policy.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by the Data Protection Officer at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows.

You wrote:

1. Please provide a copy of all Data Protection Impact Assessments carried out in relation to Police Led Partnerships (e.g. as referred to at Section 11 of the Counter Terror Policing Prevent Policy 2020).
2. Please provide a copy of any Data Sharing Agreements relating to Police Led Partnerships (e.g. as referred to at section 11 of the Counter Terror Policing Prevent Policy 2020).

Our response:

No information held - Wiltshire Police do not have any local Data Protection Impact Assessments and Data Sharing Agreements relating to Police Led Partnerships referenced in Counter Terror Policing Prevent Policy.

As Counter Terrorism Policing is a collaboration of UK police forces, it is likely that any Data Protection Impact Assessments and Data Sharing Agreements relating to Prevent and PLPs are developed, owned and maintained centrally by Counter Terrorism Policing. Therefore, under our section 16 duty to provide advice and assistance, we would advise you to contact the National Police Chiefs' Council as they may be able to assist further - [FOI and Subject Access Request](#).
