I write in connection with your request for information dated 23rd June regarding generative artificial intelligence.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by ICT at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered, and I am able to respond as follows.

You wrote (and our response):

1. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE SYSTEMS IN USE

- a. Please list all generative artificial intelligence (AI) systems which have been used by your force to produce material for courts from 1 January 2025 up to the date of this request.

No information held – AI is not permitted to be used for any court documents.

2. OFFICER TRAINING AND GUIDANCE IN GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

- a. Has your force provided training to officers in these generative AI systems during that time? When did training begin if so?

No information held – Ad hoc training has been in place for over 6 months for Copilot chat only. No other forms of AI are permitted to be used across the organisation.

- b. Is there any guidance around the use of generative AI? When was this introduced?

Yes – AI User Acceptance Policy introduced 15 December 2025

I am satisfied that all the relevant information has been passed to me and considered in the light of your request within the time constraints applicable under the legislation.
