Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by Learning and Development at Wiltshire Police.

How many hours of officer safety refresher training did you provide police officers in your force for per year for the following years, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025.

Our response:

The prescribed annual training duration for Police Officers was 12 hours per officer. The below data therefore reflects the prescribed refresher training duration for an officer completing the required annual training.

- 2020 – 12 hours
- 2021 – 12 hours
- 2022 – 12 hours
- 2023 – 12 hours
- 2024 – 12 hours
- 2025 – 12 hours
