Dear XXXXX,

I write in connection with your request for information dated 22nd August 2026, concerning property ownership.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner at Wiltshire Police.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows.

You wrote:

Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please provide recorded information that Wiltshire Constabulary maintain lawful ownership of Swindon Central Police Station and its car park provided for the use of force vehicles and vehicles of various staff, as claimed by a duty inspector in a recent social media video.

Our response:

Despite two separate requests for clarification, one relating to the social media video referenced and the other relating to the specific station address, no clarification has been provided.

As no clarification has been provided regarding which premises are being referred to as 'Swindon Central Police Station', we have not been able to confidently identify the location in question and are unable to determine what records should be searched. There have been a variety of 'centre / central' station names over the years therefore, in the absence of sufficient information to identify the property concerned, I do not believe we can provide a substantive response regarding ownership.

Under our section 16 duty to provide advice and assistance, we would advise you to provide further information relating to the social media video referenced and/or the specific station address you require information on.
