# SUMMARY OVERVIEW – 3E ENGAGEMENT, WARNINGS AND FIXED PENALTY NOTICES RELATING TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Period covering 25 February – 24 March 2021

This report covers the period from **25 February to 24 March 2021**, during this period schools reopened.

During this timeframe, Wiltshire Police have created 1,119 COVID-19 logs. This is a decrease of nine logs (-0.8%) from the last period, which includes online reports relating to COVID-19.

Seven 3Es interactions have been recorded in this period, with the focus moving to the stronger enforcement using FPNs. Of these 3Es interactions, one was regarding individuals not wearing a mask and seven related to large groups. Wiltshire also issued 170 COVID warnings during this timeframe.

Wiltshire Police have issued 168 COVID-related FPNs in this period, with 81 being issued for indoor gatherings of two or more people. There have been several large parties that officers have had to attend and disperse. One FPN was issued due to the lack of a face covering.

Wiltshire Police have, so far, issued five FPNs to individuals for failing to wear masks in public out of a total of 821 FPNs in total.
