SUMMARY OVERVIEW – 3E ENGAGEMENT, WARNINGS AND FIXED PENALTY NOTICES RELATING TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Period covering 25 March – 25 April 2021

This report covers the period from **25 March to 25 April 2021**, during which the country has taken significant steps to ease lockdown - although many restrictions are still in place.

During this timeframe, Wiltshire Police have created 795 COVID-19 logs. This is a decrease of 324 logs (-29%) from the last period, which includes online reports relating to COVID-19.

Four 3Es interactions have been recorded in this period, all of these were in relation to individuals not wearing a mask. Wiltshire also issued 35 COVID warnings during this timeframe.

Wiltshire Police have issued 33 COVID-related FPNs in this period, with 16 being issued for indoor gatherings of two or more people. One FPN was issued due to the lack of a face covering.

Wiltshire Police have, so far, issued seven FPNs to individuals for failing to wear masks in public out of a total of 878 FPNs in total.
