SUMMARY OVERVIEW – 3E ENGAGEMENT, WARNINGS AND FIXED PENALTY NOTICES RELATING TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Period covering 26 April - 25 May 2021

This report covers the period from **26 May to 25 June 2021**, during which the country has taken significant steps to ease lockdown - although many restrictions are still in place.

During this timeframe, Wiltshire Police have created 116 COVID-19 logs. This is a decrease of 60 logs (-34.1%) from the last period, which includes online reports relating to COVID-19.

No further 3Es interactions have been recorded in this period. Wiltshire issued 1 COVID warnings during this timeframe.

Wiltshire Police have issued one COVID-related FPNs in this period, relating to face coverings.

Wiltshire Police have, so far, issued eight FPNs to individuals for failing to wear masks in public out of a total of 885 FPNs since the start of the pandemic.
